Save your pet's life - get tick prevention today !

In the past 5 weeks, we have seen more than 15 cats and dogs affected by tick paralysis. This is a preventable disease - all of these pets were not up to date with their tick prevention!



For dogs, we recommend:

Bravecto (3 monthly tablet) or Nexgard (1 monthly tablet). Both of these tablets can be combined with a tick collar to further improve protection.

For cats, we recommend:

Frontline spray (every 3 weeks)

We stock all these products and can give you accurate, relevant and up to date information on when and how to use them. Drop by now and make sure your pet is protected against paralysis ticks!
